Incoming Fourth Graders

The following books have been selected for entering fourth graders and their families to read during the 2024 summer break. Please select **one book** to read and do **<u>one assignment</u>** for it. Reading and completing the activities will help prepare the student for the upcoming school year and will stress the importance of reading and the <u>pleasure to be found in books</u>. **Miami Dade County Public Schools has made Summer Reading mandatory for all grades. Assignments are due the 1st week of school.**



Directions: Choose 1 Assignment to complete.

- 1. Create a poster advertising your book so someone else will want to read it. Make sure to include the main characters, setting, and a little about the plot. Remember that this is an advertisement meant to persuade someone to read the book.
- 2. Create a collage (on a 8 ½ by 11 piece of copy or cardstock paper) using pictures from a magazine or printed from the internet to show the themes, characters, or events from your story. You may include some important words from your book around the collage. Remember that a collage means that the page should be covered.
- 3. Write an acrostic poem about one of the characters from your book. Use each letter in his/her name as the starting point for each line of your poem. Your poem should be descriptive and include character traits. For example:

Serious about his schoolwork

Always respects others

Makes others feel special
